INSTRUCTOR

Multidisciplinary artist and technician **Thierry Francis** works in the world of performance with – among others – lemieux.pilon^{4d art}, while rubbing shoulders with the corporate scene. As a special effects technician at Productions Vidosa, he has participated in many television, cinema and stage productions. In particular, he took part in *Caserne 24*, *The Day After Tomorrow*, *La veuve de St-Pierre*, *La Patente* and *Chansonnier* by Daniel Boucher, *Les Planètes* by Michel Lemieux and Victor Pilon, and *La Tempête* and *Norman* by 4d art.

lemieux.pilon^{4d art} proposes a hybrid type of show that merges reality and virtuality, performing arts and new media. The borders that separate performance, scenography, cinema, video, dance, poetry, visual arts, lighting design, music and sound exploration disappear, bringing about a total integration of the various forms of artistic expression.

Over the years, lemieux.pilon^{4d art} has developed an unequalled avant-gardist mastery of multimedia techniques applied to the performing arts.
